

Parker, Barry, & King Community Caring Award

SCHOLARSHIP TO ADVANCE CARING IN COMMUNITY/PRIMARY CARE IN NURSING BY USING THE COMMUNITY NURSING PRACTICE MODEL



The **Parker, Barry & King Community Caring Award** was established in 2013 to support attendance at the annual IAHC conference for a scholar whose work advances the science and practice of community/primary care nursing grounded in the Community Nursing Practice Model. This Award was established and sustained by Dr. Marilyn Parker and Dr. Charlotte Barry, and Dr. Beth King international scholars of caring in nursing. The Award symbolizes a commitment to the promotion of understanding and use of the Community Nursing Practice Model. An award of \$750.00 is offered toward expenses for conference participation.

Purpose of the Award

The purpose of this award is to support participation in the IAHC conference each year, to enhance understanding of caring in community/primary care nursing practice, education or research.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants for this award must meet the following criteria:

- Registered nurse committed to advance caring in community/primary care nursing.
- Member of the International Association for Human Caring
- An active student, teacher, researcher, clinician or consultant who supports human caring as the essence of nursing.

Process and Expectations

- The applicant will submit an Application Packet with the following contents:
 - A one-page paper describing the applicant's scholarship focused on caring in community nursing.
 - If an abstract for a podium or poster presentation has been submitted, the abstract replaces the one-page paper.

- A separate cover page with
 1. Applicant's name
 2. Contact information (address, phone number, and email)
- If the applicant is a student: College / university where student is enrolled & a reference letter from a faculty member who knows his/her work.
- Submit Application to the IAHC Award and Scholarship Committee at scholarships@humancaring.org

Post Award Responsibilities

- At presentations or in publications, funded research and scholarly works should indicate that it is “Funded in part by the IAHC Parker, Barry, King Community/Primary Care Nursing Practice Award.”
- Applicant must register for the annual IAHC conference to assure proper processing and recording of participation. Please indicate on the registration form that you are an award recipient.
- Respond to annual Scholarship Survey.
